After the standing type is once revised under the present law it will be comparatively easy to make the annual corrections. The work has been heavy because all the old headings are useless and new headings and rules have to be set to correspond to the requirements of the local laws which differ in all the provinces. The presentation of the departmental reports being complete will permit of the resumption of the work of setting the lists for Ontario and of revising those for the other provinces. In order, however, to keep the voters' lists at all times of the year in absolute conformity to the constant revisions of the local governments there should be, as in the Australian colonies, a room specially devoted to that object. Then the work could go on without reference to sessions of Parliament or pressure of other matter of any nature whatever.
