An Act to amend An Art respecting the Volunteer Militia Force.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The second section of an Act made and passed in the Sec. 2, of 27 V. second Session of Parliament, held in the twenty-seventh year c. 3 repealed, of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: An Act respecting the and new sect. Volunteer Militia Force, is hereby repealed, and the following section shall be taken and read in lieu thereof, and as the second section of the said Act, that is to say :---

"2. The Commander-in-Chief may raise, organize, arm, New section. uniform and equip a Volunteer Militia Force to serve within the Province for the defence of the same in case of need, and
