Uplands, Onterio	December 20th 1944	Overcast, snow flurries. Special Christmas music was played at the Music Appreciation Hour in the W.D. Recreation Centre in the evening.	
	December 21st	Ceiling and visibility unlimited. 9 hours solo flying. Revival movie in the Rec. Hall in the evening.	
	December 22nd 1944	Clear to partly cloudy. 8 hours sole flying.	
	December 23rd 1944	Snowing all day. No flying. Movie, "Summer Storm" shown to Station personnel in the evening.	
	December 24th 1944	Ground fog in morning, clearing in afternoon. A special Carol Service was held in the Chapel in the early evening. A Christmas Eve Party for Station personnel was held in the W.D. Recreation Centre, commencing with Carol singing, followed by a movie, refreshments and dancing after midnight. A most enjoyable time was had by all in attendance. Midnight Mass was celebrated in the Chapel.	
	December 25th 1944	Christmas Day. No flying carried out at this Unit. A delicious turkey dinner was served by Officers and Senior N.C.O.'s to airmen and airwomen in the Airmen's Mess at noon. An evening of small games and dancing was enjoyed by Station personnel in the W.D. Rec. Centre.	
	December 26th 1944	C.A.V.U. 8:30 hours solo flying today. LAC Corbett, R.W., carried out a wheels-up precautionary landing while on a solo navigation exercise. "D" category. No injuries sustained by pilot. LAC Wenger, D.M., landed in Main Aerodrome with undercarriage retracted. "C" category. Pilot was uninjured.	
	December 27th 1944	Overcast. Another special Christmas program was presented at the Music Appreciation Hour in the W.D. Rec. Centre.	
	December 28th	Partly cloudy, high wind. Revival movie shown in Rec. Hall.	
	December 29th 1944	Cloudy to partly cloudy. 9:30 hours solo flying. Many airmon and guests attended the Friday Night Dance in the Rec. Hall.
