

Feb. 19, 1935: House did not consider Labour items in Supply until Feb. 19th;

Took up consideration of Labour item only late in evening; merely opened up Department, no extended discussion.

Feb. 22, 1935: Sir George Perley, acting as leader, made clear intention not to proceed with Labour estimates. He said, when supply reached, Trade and Commerce, National Defence, Secretary of State would be entered.
