

Keewatin Act for the trial of the same:—

1. Any Judge of the Court of Queen's Bench of the Province of Manitoba, with the intervention of a jury of six, may try the offence in the District of Keewatin; or
2. Any Judge of the Court of Queen's Bench of that Province or a Magistrate in Keewatin may commit the offender and cause him to be conveyed to gaol in that Province for trial by the Court of Queen's Bench according to the laws in force in that Province.

The sentence may be carried into effect in a penitentiary or other place of confinement in the Province of Manitoba as if the same was in the District of Keewatin. The latter
