



Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 21st instant, in regard to the transfer of Island 36, or Snake, and 36A in Lake Huron, opposite the township of Albemarle, in the County of Bruce, and in reply to say that, after issue of Crown Grant, this Department has nothing further to do with the lands patented, and transfers thereof would, no doubt, be made in the same way as those of patented Crown lands, which transfers should be registered with the Registrar of the County in which the lands are situate, to whom a return has been made, in the usual way, of the issue of Crown grant.
