- A. No, sir.
- Q. Will you let me see your "I" Card, please?
- A. Yes, sir. (Accused shows "I" Card to the Prosecutor)
- Q. Thank you, Altenhofen. Now, did anyone tell you that the police were looking for you?
- A. No, sir.
- Q. You were not aware of the fact that they were looking for you?
- A. No, sir.
- Q. Have you had any sickness since being in the army?
- A. Just the back of my legs, sir.
- Q. Ever excused parades?
- A. Just had stomach trouble one day.
- This new home you built, is it paid for?
- A. Yes, sir.
- . Q. How much have you invested in it sofar?
- A. I couldn't say for sure?
- Q. Give me a rough idea?
- A. About four or five hundred dollars counting the lots.
- Q. What are the lots worth?
- A. About 20 dollars apeice.
- after the Provost arrested you at Forest Lawn, did they take you back to your home before taking you back to A 16?
- I asked them if I could finish the load and deliver it where the cow was and take the truck home and come back. They said yes.
- They permitted you to do this?
