



REV. JOHN DOUGLAS, B. A.

**T**HE RECTOR, Rev. John Douglas, B. A., is a graduate of the University of Toronto and also of the Diocesan Theological College, Montreal. Besides, he holds the Canada Voluntary Preliminary Certificate, and thus is entitled to three graduating hoods. At the age of eighteen he began teaching and obtained Third Class and Second Class Public School Certificates, and also Second and First Class Academy Diplomas for High Schools. After teaching twelve years he entered the ministry, being ordained Deacon 1903, Priest 1904, by Archbishop Bond. For a short time he was connected with L'Eglise du Redempteur, Montreal; for four years incumbent of Nanticoke, during which time he presented 78 candidates for confirmation. In 1908 he was made Rector of Grace Church, Waterdown, where he has been active in restoring Church property and building a Vestry and Parish Hall.
