

by a period of supervised study. After tea, there is another period of study for those who need it, but all pupils have a period of recreation before retiring for the night.

Application for Admission

PARENTS desiring to enter their daughters should fill in the Application for Admission, which may be had from the School, and return it to the Principal. It is desirable that application for a place in Residence should be sent in early.

When it is not possible at once to accommodate all accepted candidates, a Waiting List is formed and the names on the list are given prior consideration when vacancies occur in the Residence. An Outfit List is sent to each candidate when a place is reserved for her, and she is expected to be guided by this list in respect of the clothing she brings with her to the School.

Pocket money for the girls should be sent in advance, and *separately from the School Account*. It is desirable that all such money be handed over to the House Bursar for safe keeping. A Pocket-Money Bank is open every Saturday.

Divine Service

THE girls attend Divine Service in Church every Sunday, and sit together in seats specially reserved for their use. No fixed charge is made by the Church authorities, but envelope contributions are customary. With a view to training the girls in proportionate giving, and also in order that they may bear a reasonable and proper share in the financial support of the church they attend,
