

W E D N E S D A Y, 7th March, 1792.

The order of the day being read—

Resolve.

*Resolved*, that the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas for King's county be requested to take such measures for facilitating the communication and accommodating travellers at the Portage on the *Kennebeckacis* at or near *George Manning's* as they may judge best; and that this House will make provision to defray any expence thereby to be incurred, not exceeding *Twenty Five Pounds*.
