### UNVEILED IN OTTAWA.

A Monument Erected in Memory of Sir John Macdonald.

Parliament Hill, Ottawa, was on Monday the scene of an imposing unveiling ceremony. The occasion being the unveiling of a monument to the late Sir John Macdonald. The day was grand one. The blue sky and the green trees made a sharp contrast to the thousands of soldiers in uniform who were present. The unveiling of the monument took place at the hour of noon. The Royal Scots of Montreal, with the independent and municipal soldiers of Ottawa, formed the sides of a square, in front of the Parliament building. A salute of fifteen guns was fired at noon by the local field battery, then a mighty cheer went forth from the thousands of soldiers and civilians. On the platform were assembled the speakers of the day and many distinguished guests. Sir Mackenzie Bowell, Sir Adolphe Caron, Foster, Mr. Dely, Mr. D. J. Dickey and Mr. Montague occupied prominent positions. With them were the Lieutenant-Governor of Ontario, James South, and Prince Edward Island, Chief Justice Strong, Speaker White and many members of both houses of Parliament.
