THE BUDGET SPEECH.

FOLLOWING is the official report of the Budget Speech, delivered by the Hon. W. W. Sullivan, Premier and Attorney-General, in the House of Assembly, Charlottetown, on Friday the 13th instant.

The Leader of the Government moved that the House go into the order of the day, and said: Mr. Speaker, before the House goes into Committee on the present financial state of the Province, I would like to say a few words on the subject of the Budget.

On the 27th March last, the House resolved to the effect that the House would, on the next day, go into Committee on the Budget, but that the hon. member for St. John's, thought it was hardly treating the Opposition to consider the finances of the Province on such brief notice; for, it will be remembered, the Budget was not tabled but a very short time before the motion was made.

The hon. member thought the Opposition were entitled to at least a week for the purpose of making themselves sufficiently acquainted with the details of the Budget, and he was accordingly moved to amend the resolution of the House, so that the Budget should be tabled on the 27th of March.

into their pockets and contribute a portion of the expense of working our school system, they are more particularly in guarding their own interests and in seeing that they receive corresponding advantages in introducing that amendment, therefore, the Government were forwarding the interests of education in this Province, whilst, at the same time, reducing the annual expenditure thereon to the extent of about \$100,000 per year.
