TRADE IN CANADA.

The Volume of Business is Restricted, But Prospects are Very Encouraging.

The Daily Bulletin (R. G. Dun & Co.) says: The week has been a broken one, and there has been little alteration in trade conditions at Montreal since last report. Drygoods travelers, with few exceptions, are writing up their prospects for fall trade, and are sending in very fair orders. In boots and shoes, there is a large manufacturers' report of a decline from 25 to 50 per cent. since this date last year, and collections in this line during June were better than anticipated. Groceries are not showing special activity, but show a moderate seasonable movement. Iron and metals generally are dull, also oils, paints and glue. There is no active buying of leather yet, but values are well held. Some offers for large blocks of Cape wool have been received here from New York, but the figures offered were not sufficiently high to lead to business. The notable advances of the week are silk ribbons put up 7 1/2 to 10 per cent., striped blouse silks are also advanced. The wool market is very firm at an advance of 1 cent. in the last week. Some shippers of live stock have been somewhat checked in the past two weeks, but the market is satisfactory. For the season there are satisfactory reports from Montreal, a decrease of 784 as compared with the corresponding month of last year, but for the season they aggregate 29,852, an increase of 708. In June 14,000 head of cattle were shipped from the same port, an increase of 7405 over June of last year, and for the season 15,540 head, an increase of 10,055 the same period of 1894.

## PREPARING FOR HOLIDAYS.

Much Routine Business Transacted at the City Hall.

The Executive Committee, Ald. Shaw in the chair, passed the reports of the other committees preparatory to their presentation to council on Monday afternoon. Many macadam pavements were endorsed, the Brock-street temporary crossing by Grand Trunk tracks approved under provisions. Three months' notice will be given the Canadian Pacific Railway to remove their siding from Beach-street. The Toronto Railway Company get their siding of the Esplanade, Contractor Grant was relieved from his duty-street paving contract, his deposit of \$90 forfeited, and the work ordered to be re-advertised. A water supply will be furnished Emsley-place from St. Joseph-street.

A bylaw will be introduced into council in connection with the leasing of Island in the park already laid down. The Corporation will be leasing five years, from Jan. 1, 1896, at 20-1/2 cents per light per night, or \$74,821.20 per light per annum, minimum number of lights to be 1000, was sent on to council, also were the tenders for new beach, Dundas street, and additions to Lombard-street fire hall.

Tenders For Coal.

City Commissioner Goatsworth reported to the chairman of the Property Committee that the tender of the Standard Fuel Company is lowest in the aggregate for coal for the year and wood to the municipal buildings for the current year. The total amount of quantities enumerated in the specifications is \$2949, at the following figures: lineal coal, \$3.95 per ton, soft coal \$3.59 per ton, screenings \$2.34 per ton, hard wood \$3.90 per cord, pine wood \$2.80 per cord. Elias Rogers & Co. offered hard coal for \$3.65, but the higher tender was not accepted. The tender in the aggregate than the Standard Fuel Company. Other prices submitted for hard coal were: \$3.90, \$4.10 and \$4.40 per ton.

The Executive sent on to council the tender of the Standard Fuel Company.

An Official Collector of Tax Assessors.

Ald. Jolliffe's sub-committee on Fees for Bailiffs retained to disburse for taxes the several tax collectors to request all warrants against the goods and chattels of those in arrears in the hands of J. Curry, 22 Victoria-street, for collection. Mr. Curry having offered to do the work for five per cent. commission until the sum reaches \$8000, the committee which the city to receive the total receipts. The percentage charge is to be borne by the ratepayer against whom the warrant has been issued, but when the percentage on the amount collected exceeds the statutory fee the statute fee only shall be collected.

The Executive deferred consideration of this report.

Toronto Bonds Will Be Offered in Lots.

Mayor Kennedy will put the \$1.2 per cent. bonds on the market at a minimum price of 94 1/2-22. The mayor is of opinion that a price several points in excess of this will be obtained. The bonds will be offered on lot or in lots to suit purchasers. By this arrangement if the highest offer is for \$50,000 or \$100,000 worth of the debenture, that quantity will be sold, and the next highest offer taken for the remainder or such quantity as may be desired. The whole issue is disposed of. The advertisements calling for tenders and the list of bidders will be published in a day or two.

Arbitration.

The Hober arbitration award has not yet been presented to City Hall. The arbitration to fix the value of property to be taken from H. B. and J. W. Slater commenced yesterday. The owners asked the city \$7000.
