The author of the foregoing work, after spending considerable time and doing much writing under another heading or title, is not satisfied with his work, and has finally decided to adopt "Me Woman versus Me Man," as the title and the foundation of a work setting forth the principles of human government as foreshadowed by the Bible and corroborated by natural law. This title is apt and directly to the point, as it takes at least two differently constituted affinities to form a perfect and harmonious union in natural law, so, in like manner, no perfect and harmonious system of human government can be organized, or long maintained, with the affinity of woman left out of its organic construction, and the science and sequel to "Me Woman versus Me Man," will prove an appropriate addition to the foregoing literary effort.
