



Poison in the Kitchien,—We are all being poisoned by inches! If you do not believe it, read the following from the "Journal of Chemistry:" "Dr. Emil Querner, of Fhiladelphia, writes us that since we called attention to the subject he has fetted a great number of tin vessels from different sources with nitric acid and a solition of iodide of potassium, and found lead in every case. If e adds: 'All my vessels for cook ing, elc., are now made of sheet from and give enlire satisfaction.'" And the "Journal of Chemistry" advises the use of sheet from instead of the tinware which has been found to be subject to poisonous manipulation. This evidence of scientific men, published in a scientific journal, only substantiated other evidence which I have carefully gathered from widely different sources, shewing that, in the competitions of trade, cheap tinware, composed largely of soluble lead, is now coming into daily sie in our kitchens, our dairies, our milk palls, our tin cans, in which all varieties of camed meats, fish, vegetables and fruits are kept, in the pots used to prepare our tea and coffeen and the vessels used for cooking almost every variety of food.
