To KEEP FLOWERS FRESH.—A little saltpetre or carbonate of soda, mixed with the water in which flowers are placed will keep them fresh for two weeks.

EGGLESS CAKE.—One and one-half teacups of sugar, one teacup of sour milk, three teacups of flour, one and one-half teacups of butter, one teaspoonful of soda, one-half teaspoonful of cinnamon, one-half teaspoonful of nutmeg, one teacup of raisins chopped and floured.

SAGO PUDDING.—Boil five table-spoonfuls of sago, well-picked and washed, in one quart of milk till quite soft, with a stick of cinnamon; stir in one teacup of butter and two of white sugar; when cold, add six eggs well beaten and nutmeg to taste. Mix all well together and bake in a butter-dish three-quarters of an hour.

FRUIT CAKE.—Two cups of molasses, two cups of brown sugar, two cups of butter, one cup of milk, five cups of flour, five eggs, one pound of raisins, one pound of currants, one-half pound of citron, one teaspoonful of ginger, and one teaspoonful of nutmeg, one and a half teaspoonful of allspice, add one and a half of cloves.

HOMINY.—Soak one cup of small hominy for two hours in enough water to cover it. Drain and put in a double boiler with one quart of warm water and a little salt. Cook one-half hour after it reaches the boil. If all the water is not soaked into the hominy pour it off, turn in a cup of milk, bring it to a boil and serve.

BAKED OMELET.—Take six eggs (three even spoonfuls of flour, a little salt, and beat them well together—the more it is beaten the lighter it will be—then add one pint of hot milk and keep on beating. Have a hot dish with some melted butter the size of an egg, and put into the oven. Bake twenty minutes, and eat when it comes from the oven, for it will fall soon. This is very nice for breakfast.

NUT CAKES.—Half cup of sugar, scant half cup of butter, two eggs, half cup of water, one and a half cups of flour, with a teaspoonful of cream of tartar sifted in it. Cream the butter and sugar, add the yolks of eggs, the water, with half a teaspoonful of soda dissolved in it, and the flour, add the whites well beaten last. Flour one cup of hickory nuts and add them the last thing. Bake in small cake tins and frost.

A NEW GATEWAY.

WASHINGTON OMELET.—One cup milk, six eggs, table-spoonful butter, salt and pepper, one teacupful bread crumbs. Let the milk come to a boil, pour it over the crumbs, and let stand a few minutes. Break open the eggs and stir till well mixed; add the bread and milk and season. Melt the butter on a hot skillet, pour on the omelet and let it cook slowly; cut in squares, turn, fry it a delicate brown, and serve immediately.
