SUPPLEMENTARY FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

I have the honour to refer to your letter of the 19th December, 1946, in regard to the temporary suspension of the preferential rate of duty on wool tops and combed wool guaranteed to the Union under the Canadian-Union Wool Agreement of 1932, for a period of six months, up to the 30th June, 1947.

I now have the honour to inform you that the Union Government has agreed to the temporary suspension of the preferential rate of 10 cents per weight on wool tops and combed wool for the period 1st January to 30th June, 1947.
