5. It is understood that the application of the provisions of Sections 4, 5 and 7 of the Annex to the said Agreement to the return services described in Sections 1 and 2 of the said Annex shall not be affected by the provisions of the present modification."

If the Government of Canada is agreeable to the foregoing modification of the said Agreement of 16 August, 1950, I suggest that this letter, and your reply in similar terms, should be regarded as placing on record the agreement of our two Governments.
