The Department of External Affairs presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America and has the honour to refer to the Embassy's Note No. 32 of February 13, 1969, and to the Exchange of Notes of September 29 and October 6, 1966,⁽¹⁾ concerning the establishment of a co-operative meteorological rocket project at Cold Lake, Alberta.

The Department of External Affairs is pleased to inform the Embassy that the Government of Canada accepts the Embassy's proposal to replace the PWN-6A meteorological rocket system in use at Cold Lake with the PWN-8B system, in accordance with the provisions contained in the Embassy's Note No. 32.

The Department of External Affairs is therefore pleased to inform the Embassy that the Government of Canada agrees that the Embassy's Note No. 32 of February 13, 1969, and this reply, which is authentic in English and French, shall constitute an amendment to the above agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of this Note.

The Department of External Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the United States of America the assurances of its highest consideration.
