THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCES THAT MR ZULFIQAR ALI BHUTTO, MINISTER OF COMMERCE FOR PAKISTAN, WILL VISIT CANADA THIS WEEK PRIMARILY TO DISCUSS THE POSSIBILITIES OF INCREASING TRADE BETWEEN CANADA AND PAKISTAN. HE WILL SEE THE PRIME MINISTER, THE MINISTER OF FINANCE, THE MINISTER OF TRADE AND COMMERCE AND VARIOUS GOVERNMENTAL OFFICIALS ON OCTOBER 22ND AND 23RD, AS WELL AS PRIVATE BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL EXECUTIVES IN MONTREAL OCTOBER 21ST AND TORONTO THE AFTERNOON OF OCTOBER 23RD AND OCTOBER 24TH.

MR. BHUTTO, WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY REPRESENTED PAKISTAN AT THE CONFERENCE ON THE LAW OF THE SEA AND A MINISTERIAL COUNCIL MEETING OF THE BAGHDAD PACT, WILL LEAVE FOR NEW YORK ON OCTOBER 25 WHERE HE IS TO LEAD THE PAKISTAN DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS.
