Mr. Winters, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Governor General,—Annual Report of the Department of Resources and Development for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1951. (English and French).

Mr. McIlraith, Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Trade and Commerce, laid before the House,—Copy of Order in Council P.C. 6653, approved December 11, 1951: Establishing "Regulations respecting the Labelling of Turpentine", and passed under the provisions of The National Trade Mark and True Labelling Act, Statutes of Canada 1949 (Second Session) Chapter 31.
