SUPPLY**CONCURRENCE IN SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES (B)**

Hon. Yvon Pinard (President of the Privy Council): Mr. Speaker, there are some 15 opposed items to the Supplementary Estimates (B). We have had consultations and agreed amongst ourselves to dispose of those 15 opposed items by having three recorded divisions as follows: The vote on item 1 will dispose of Item No. 12. The second recorded division, a vote on item No. 2 will dispose of items Nos. 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13 and 15. The third recorded division, a vote on item No. 5, will dispose of items Nos. 6 and 14. In so far as the unopposed items are concerned, you will realize later that they will go through on division.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: Is that agreed?

Mr. Nielsen: That is substantially correct, Mr. Speaker. The votes on all motions will be recorded as though a recorded division had taken place. Earlier this afternoon the Member for Hamilton Mountain asked for consent to delete Motion No. 4. We provide that consent now.

Mr. Deans: Mr. Speaker, I appreciate receiving the consent. It is not necessary. We are prepared to take the votes as they were indicated by the President of the Privy Council. I agree with the comments of the House Leader for the Conservative Party.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: Agreed and so ordered. The next question is on Motion No. 1. This vote will also apply to Motion No. 12.
