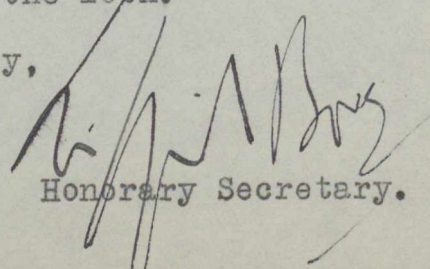
Dear Sir Arthur:-
