

XXI.—Proprietors and Subscribers are on no account whatever to move or displace books ; and the Librarian has been directed to carry this order into effect strictly, (ladies excepted.)

XXII.—The Cómmittee shall determine from tiime to time what books, newspapers, maps and periodical publications shall be admitted into the institution, but any proprietor or annual Subscriber may propose what publication he may think proper, by entering the title, and other particulars, in a book to be kept in the Library for that purpose.

XXIII.—No pamphlet or periodical publication is to be taken out of the Library room until one month after its arrival.

XXIV.—It is expected that silence be observed in the Library room.
