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<i>nabigwontcek</i> , River Burgeois, C. B.; [2] Fourth Lake on Fort Medway River.	<i>naspludumok</i> , ; he mocks me.
<i>naboosakun</i> , Ábusakun, N. B.; a bead-string.	<i>natwagemk</i> , Sydney Forks.
<i>naboosakunnuk</i> , St. Mary's, N. B. place for stringing beads.	<i>nebeltook</i> , Bartibog.
<i>naduokun</i> , near Miramichi; the eeling-place.	<i>neganaboodik</i> , passage near Balcom Head; sights ahead.
<i>nāēādīc</i> , Chiverie Split.	<i>neliksak</i> , Arichat; split rock, or rocky cliffs.
<i>nalegitkunētc</i> , Antigonish; broken branches. Note: It is said that there the bears broke down branches to get the beech-nuts.	<i>nemakunatpatc</i> , Williams Island, Beaver Harbour.
<i>nankul</i> , (<i>minegool</i>), Five Islands; the five islands.	<i>nemtoogowak</i> , Johnstown, on Bras d'or Lake, the sitting-up place.
<i>nāooktaboogwadek</i> , Chiverie point; it stands alone.	<i>nenādoogweboogwek</i> , a river between Truro and Hantsport.
<i>nāopskuk</i> , place near Mirimichi; the lone rock.	<i>nesakunētkik</i> , river at Onslow, Colchester Co., N. S.
<i>naspadakun</i> , Prospect, near Halifax.	<i>neseamk</i> , Sable River, Shelburne Co.
