

- Labels. **5.** Every article of food or the package that contains it which is placed in cold storage shall bear a yellow paper label in form A in the schedule to this Act, upon which shall be plainly stamped or printed in black letters, and figures, at least one-half inch long, the date of the killing, packing, or manufacturing, and the date when the same was placed in cold storage. When food is removed from cold storage a red paper label in form B in the said schedule stamped or printed in black letters at least one-half inch long shall be attached to such article or package. 5 10
- Storage period limited. **6.** The articles of food mentioned in the schedule to this Act shall not be kept in cold storage for longer periods than are severally specified in the said schedule, except with the written consent of the Minister as hereinafter provided.
- Extension of time. **7.** The Minister may grant permission to extend the period of cold storage beyond the time limited by the schedule to this Act in the case of any food or package of food, if the same are found upon examination to be in proper condition for further storage. 15
- Goods exposed for sale. **8.** When food that has been placed in cold storage is taken out of cold storage and exposed for sale, the person offering the same for sale shall inform any person making enquiry that such food has been in cold storage, and the dates when such food was first placed in cold storage and when it was removed therefrom. 20 25
- Marks. **9.** All food taken out of cold storage and offered for sale shall be marked with a card upon which shall be plainly printed in red block letters not less than two inches long, upon a white ground, the words "Cold Storage Goods."
- Tainted food. **10.** No food which is tainted or is otherwise unfit for human consumption shall be placed in cold storage. 30
- Register. **11.** The owner, operator or manager of every cold storage shall keep a book in which each article placed in cold storage shall be entered, with the date when the same was first placed in cold storage and when it was taken out of the same. The said book shall at all times be open for inspection by all persons authorized to inspect the same by the Minister, and also to all health officers. 35
- Returns. **12.** The owner, operator or manager of every cold storage shall make on the first day of each month returns to the Minister, verified by affidavit, in such form as the Minister may prescribe, which returns shall include a list 40
