The Synod then adjourned to the School Room of the Columbia College.

On motion the Rev. D. H. W. Horlock was elected Clerical Secretary and Dr. Trew Lay Secretary.

The Roll of Members was then called and a quorum reported present.

The "Order of Proceedings" was introduced by Report from the Standing Committee of the Conference, and, on motion, was taken into consideration, Clause by Clause, and adopted.

Rules for the Preservation of Order were reported by the Standing Committee.

Clauses I to XV were adopted.

On motion Clause XVI was amended to read: "All Committees shall be appointed by the Bishop, unless appointed by special vote of the Synod, and the names shall be publicly announced during a sitting of the Synod."

Clauses XVII to XXII, inclusive, were adopted.

On motion Clause XXIII was amended by adding thereto the words "saving only the preceding rule No. XXII."

On motion the "Rules of Order," as amended, were adopted.

The Synod then adjourned till 2 P.M.

At 2 P.M. the Synod met pursuant to adjournment, a quorum being present.

The report of the Standing Committee appointed by the Conference on the 13th of April, 1882, was then presented, and, on motion, received.

On motion the "Canon for the Election of a Bishop" was taken into consideration.

Amendments to Clauses II, VI, IX, and X were adopted, and the Canon, as amended, was then adopted.

On motion the "Canon on Boundaries of Parishes" was taken into consideration, and was referred back to the Standing Committee for amendments.

On motion the "Canons on Definitions of Clergy and Parishes" was taken up.

Amendments to Clauses II and V were adopted, and the Canon, as a whole, was then adopted, as amended, and the Synod adjourned till 6.30 P.M.

At 6.30 P.M. the Synod re-assembled, a quorum being present.
