It would be inconfiftent with such Conduct, it would be unjust to such Characters, to suppose even for a Moment, that they would suffer the Canadians to remain a single and solitary Instance, of a People subjected to Laws and Institutions, so very different from, and so greatly inserior to, those Laws by which every other Part of the British Dominions are governed.
