

ART. 29.—No member shall, on any pretence or ^{No profits or gratuities.} receive any profit, salary or emolument from the funds of the Club ; nor shall any member give any money or gratuity to any of the servants of the establishment, upon any pretence whatever. It being understood that this rule is not intended to preclude any member of the Club from selling property, or goods, or stocks, or other money securities to the Club, or buying any of the same from the Club.

ART. 30.—No member shall take away from the ^{Take away papers.} Club upon any pretence whatsoever, any newspaper, pamphlet, book, map, or other article, the property of the Institution.

ART. 31.—No servant of the Club (the messenger ^{Servants on errands.} excepted) shall be sent out of the house upon any errands, on any pretence whatever.

ART. 32.—No provisions cooked in the Club- ^{Provisions &c., taken out.} House, or wines or other liquors, to be sent out of the House on any pretence whatever.

ART. 33.—Any cause of complaint that may ^{Complaints.} arise, is to be written and signed by the member so complaining, on his bill ; which complaint must be specially noticed by the Committee, on settling the weekly accounts ; and any inattention or improper conduct of a servant is to be stated by letter, under the signature of such member, which being put in the Secretary's box, must be laid before the Committee, at their next weekly meeting.
