the Committee find such candidate qualified as well as regards education, as good conduct, there shall then be granted him a certificate of these facts signed by the President and countersigned by the Secretary.

XXII.—No Member of the Association shall receive into his office as a Student any person who has not previously submitted himself for examination to the said Committee and obtained from them a certificate of qualification as above stated, and every member who shall contravene this regulation shall be expelled from the Association.

EXILV.—The last named Committee shall be charged with the examination of all certificates, papers and documents of Candidates for admission into the profession, and should the said Committee believe that the indentureship of any Candidate has not been regularly completed or that such Candidate has not the requisite certificates to be admitted into the profession, they are hereby authorised to oppose the reception of such Candidate and to submit to the Judges in the name of the Body either verbally or in writing the reasons of their opposition the same Committee shall also examine before the Judges all aspirants to the profession.
