MILLINERY FORECASTS.

There are a number of curious style features in the new imported millinery. One in the use of ostrich feathers as bands about the edge of wide and narrow hat brims. The upper part of the band will have the two ends of the feather fronds caught under and hidden, while on the lower half of the band the fronds fall in a deep fringe sometimes curled, sometimes straight, sometimes crimped, which last is novel.

Another novelty is the wonderful fiery pink, reds and the strange called "meadow" hues and are perhaps the effect of the fire and flames of battle on the minds of textile fabricants, there is the rust of steel as well as the lurid tones of warfare.

While hats are covered with rust-colored velvet, and brims of black velvet hats are of the curious pink or deep red duvetyn.

There are several hints of the Third Empire modes in hats. There is medium-sized mushroom shape with rather high crown; a flat tan shape, and others with narrow brim and conical shapes in the new importations. Narrow ribbons are a millinery feature. One with a fringed edge is a favorite. Figured Ottoman ribbons, very old-timey looking, show quaint rose garlands. Others show posies, as well as interwoven gold stripes. These are to encircle black velvet hat crowns, tied in snappy bows for there is a striking tendency to lighten the dark velvet hats in this fashion. Two encircling strips, entirely independent, often are used on one hat.

Some of the new turbans have odd fan-shaped wings. One long, low and wide, with a wide edge of round, but delicate bands.

Knitted caps, both bowl shaped and cylindrical, and in gay mixtures of colors, have also been imported from France, with marching sweaters.

The vogue of the Tam-o-Shanter shaped in summer hats is very pronounced in French hats. So we may expect to see a continuation of this shape in autumn modes. It does not seem as if there could be many more variations. The brims diverge gracefully, crown in the more dressy variations.

HOUSEWIVES MUST USE LESS WHEAT, BEEF AND BACON

Conserve Food and Help Allies Win the War.

CRITICAL STAGE IS NOW

Economy Is Vital if Famine at Home Is To Be Averted.

Mrs. David Williams, "Bishopstowe," who was appointed chairman of the London committee of the Women's Auxiliary of the Organization of Resources Committee, at the organization meeting held some days ago, makes the following appeal to the housewives of London in connection with the food conservation movement:

The Housewife and the War. We are now in the most critical stage of this war, and the most vital question at this critical stage is how to feed our allies in Europe and our soldiers at the front. The great needs are wheat, beef and bacon. To secure enough of these, the housewives of Canada must use one-sixth less wheat and nearly one-third less beef and bacon than they have been using. The Government has enforced this by law in hotels and restaurants, but neither beef nor bacon may be served on Tuesday and Fridays, and other than white bread must be served at every meal.

In the Homes, Too. Now we appeal to the housewives of this district to carry out the same regulations in their homes. Success in conserving food will depend much more upon us, the thousands of housewives, than upon the comparatively few hotels and restaurants.

Remember, the danger is not alone that our soldiers and allies will suffer, but that we at home will starve, if not famine conditions. For the fact is that next year there will not be enough of these three great commodities to go around unless we economize and substitute this year. It is unnecessary that our soldiers, who are fighting our battles and risking their lives, should have their food cut down. Any shortage of food, before, fall upon us, and there, to save ourselves from starvation or famine conditions next year, we must conserve our food, especially wheat, beef and bacon.

Must Eat Less.

How is this to be done? We answer: We must all use one-sixth less wheat (whether in the form of flour or in any other form), and in making bread use oatmeal, cornmeal, buckwheat or rye flour mixed with white flour, to the extent of at least one-sixth.

2. We must all use two-sevenths less of beef and bacon, and use fish, eggs, beans, rice, potatoes, etc., instead on two days out of seven.

3. We must all avoid waste. It has been figured that the people of Canada throw away every year \$50,000,000 worth of food every year. If you are not very careful, you are wasting your money. Before you throw away anything, ask yourself, "Will this help me win the war?"
