Whereas, the indebtedness of the Fund at this date en \$19,000,—nearly \$6,000 above the debt at the same period last whereas the estimated expenditure of the current year is \$43,000; and whereas the Committee are satisfied that only strong and general effort the income of the year can be made to the expenditure; Resolved, that the Convener be instructed quest all the Presbyteries of the Church to use the utmost diligen secure liberal contributions to the Home Mission scheme from a Congregation and Station within their bounds, and hereby into that in the event of sufficient funds not being forthcoming prior to March meeting of the Committee, they will be under the necess deducting a percentage from the claims of all Presbyteries for Sumented Congregations and Mission Stations for the half year en 31st March next, so as to equalize the expenditure with the int of the year.

The Committee further earnestly request Presbyteries careful revise every application for aid with a view to increase the contribut of the people in the respective fields, and to reduce the grants from Home Mission Fund.
