Librarian, and in March, 1872, Vicar of All Saints' Church, Kingston. In May, 1886, he resigned the latter office, as also the Librarianship, and obtained leave of absence. He died as St. Catharines, Ontario, on the 12th August, 1888. Mr. Bousfield was a life member of the Widowsand Orphans' Clergy Fund, and a beneficiary of the Clergy Trust Commutation Fund.

Mr. William Shea, of Trenton, was for many years a lay delegate from that parish to the Diocesan Synod. Of him the Reverend F. W. Armstrong reports that he was always faithful to his duties, a good Churchman, and a liberal subscriber. He died on the 13th October, 1888, at the advanced age of 76 years and 9 months.

The attention of the Committee has been called to the death of an old Churchman, who, although not a member of the Synod, it may not be inappropriate to refer to in this report. John Reid was Sexton of the Parish of Carrying Place, in the Parish of Trenton, for 42 unbroken years, and it is said that during that period he was only absent from duty on three Sundays. He died in November, 1888, aged 75 years.

CONFIRMATION OF CANONS.

THE REGISTRAR AND HIS DUTIES.

On motion of the Chancellor, seconded by the Archdeacon of Kingston, the following Canon was confirmed :----

CANON LIV.- TO AMEND CANON XLVIII, RESPECTING THE REGISTRAR AND HIS DUTIES.

That Section 7 of Canon XLVIII. be repealed and the following substituted therefor : "The Registrar shall keep a correct record of the Letters of Orders, the Licenses, Induction Mandates, and other legal instruments, issued by the Bishop to the Clergy of the Diocese from time to time; and on request the said Registrar shall furnish certified copies of any such record; and for each such copy he shall be entitled to charge the following fee, viz.:
