2,000 OFF FOR WEST FROM N. S. AND P. E. I.

Many Women Amongst Harvesters Leaving Sister Provinces For Grain Fields.

HALIFAX, Aug. 11—There was an exodus of over 2,000 young men and women from Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island today en route to the grain fields of Western Canada, according to figures compiled by the officials of the railroads handling the traffic.

Many of the married men took their families with them, hoping to find it possible to locate permanently in the West, and special cars were set aside for accommodation of the women.

There were two special trains from Prince Edward Island, one from Halifax and one from Cape Breton, while several hundred travelled by regular trains and boats from the western end of the province to connect with special trains from Saint John. They will all travel direct to Winnipeg.

U. S. Miners' Strike Viewed As Certain

MONTREAL, Aug. 11—James Duncan, first Vice-President of the American Federation of Labor, and for many years chief lieutenant of Samuel Gompers, says the threatened coal strike in the United States will certainly take place, there being nothing, as far as he can see, that can possibly avert it.

"The greatest fight," he declared, "will be in connection with the check-off, which the coal mine owners consider unreasonable and which the men demand."
