

Ancient Seal of Town Is Adopted

LONDON, Nov. 17—Oil, in the opinion of so high an authority as Sir Richard Redmayne, formerly Chief Inspector of Mines, will never be a serious rival to coal.

The supply of oil, Sir Richard told the Coal Commission, is restricted, and an American authority had estimated that the petroleum supplies of the United States would be exhausted in 12 years.

Taking everything into account, it was doubtful if the world's supply of natural mineral oil would suffice for more than 80 to 100 years.
