The Committee on Sabbath Schools having failed to report, the following Resulution was adopted:

Resolved, That this Association esteem the religious education of the young to be of paramount importance, deeply so, to the present, and in all probability, to the rising generation, and they would earnestly recommend to the Churches, the establishment and cordial support of Sabbath Schools and Bible classes.

The following Resolution was also unanimously adopted :-

Resolved, That in view of the great mercy of our Heavenly Father, which has been bestowed upon many of our Churches during the past year, in their being revived, and receiving additions to their numbers, of souls converted by the grace of God,—we hereby thank the Divine goodness, and implore the gracious assistance of the Holy Spirit to lead us on to a fuller consecration of ourselves to the service of God.

After which Prayer was offered by Rev. D. W. C. Dimock, the Union Hymn sung, and the Association adjourned to meet next year at Pugwash, the Moderator having pronounced the benediction.
