An Act to relieve Registrars of Counties in Upper Canada from certain disabilities.

W HEREAS it is expedient to relieve Registrars of Counties in Upper Canada from the disability to practice as Attorneys or Solicitors, imposed upon them by the Act hereinafter cited : Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

1. So much of the fifth section of the Act twenty-second Victoria, chapter ninety-four, to extend the provisions of the Act to amend the law for the Admission of Attorneys, as provides that no person shall practice as an Attorney or Solicitor of any Court of Law or Equity in Upper Canada, who shall, either in his own person, or by his partner, deputy or agent, or in the name of any other person, or otherwise, directly or indirectly hold, possess, practice, carry on or conduct the office of Registrar of any County or Union of Counties in Upper Canada, and that every such person so practising shall be subject to the forfeiture of such office, and shall, in addition thereto, be subject to a penalty of five hundred pounds, shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.
