"The Sandbox", with Sharon Pollack, Mary Ellen Moore, Gordon Cunningham and Stephen Finch, is a provocative play which presents a rather pathetic facet of modern life. "Krapp's Last Tape" is an attempt by a cynical old man to deny the fact that he was once alive. This one-character drama starrs Alvin Shaw, receiver of the Canadian Drama Award in recognition of his services to Canadian theatre.
