Dear Sir:

The councils of the Fisher River and Peguis Bands wish to enact a by-law prohibiting the use of heavy trucks on the road through the reserves. They claim, and their claim is justified, that the traffic of the Indian or a light vehicle does not damage the road but that the traders' heavy trucks are continually breaking through culverts and in bad weather cutting the roads to pieces.

Have you any specified by-law form in use in the Department for the controlling of this traffic or shall I prepare a by-law for the Indians to govern same.
