Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th ultimo, with which you forwarded Bank draft for \$1795.31, being principal and interest to the 5th of October on the loans enumerated therein, and in reply I have to request that you will state whether you have given the correct Band numbers opposite entries Nos 14, 69, 85, 105 and 109.
