B.C. asking him to ascertain from the Chiefs, if he can, the facts as to this matter and would suggest that your Agent communicate with our Agent Mr. Graham with a view of clearing this matter up. If this formality of taking out Letters of Administration for the purpose of securing a proper conveyance is necessary, the Department would undertake to be responsible for the Court fees in the matter but it does not appear that there is any estate on which an administrator would be entitled to a commission.
