at about 2200hrs on Friday, 29th, september, 1944, I was walk in the vicinity of ST. PETERS SQUARE. I jeep, being driftrom behind, was handled in a dangerous manner.

Recause I was in danger of being knocked down by the vehicle I called to the driver as he attempted to to the jeep in the road. Owing to the severe handling the gears became disengaged and the vehicle stopped.

I went to the driver to remonstrate with him and I notised that he appeared to be under the influence of drink.

He was a Canadian and the vehicle was an R.A.I jeep. I ordered him to dismount. I then advised the nearest R.A.F.Police Establishment by two messengers of the OF/FI.

About half an Lour later two members of the R.A.F. Police arrived and recognised the vehicle. They too the Canadian into custody.
