WITNESS: No. 350. Lieutenant. SF DADSON, 3rd. CANADIAN FIELD
SURVEY Coy.

At about 2200hrs on Friday, 29th, September, 1944, I was walk in the vicinity of ST. PETERS SQUARE. A jeep, being driven from behind, was handled in a dangerous manner.

Because I was in danger of being knocked down by the vehicle I called to the driver as he attempted to turn the jeep in the road. Owing to the severe handling the gears became disengaged and the vehicle stopped.

I went to the driver to remonstrate with him and I noticed that he appeared to be under the influence of drink.

He was a Canadian and the vehicle was an R.A.I. jeep. I ordered him to dismount. I then advised the nearest R.A.F. Police Establishment by two messengers of the OP/FI.

About half an hour later two members of the R.A.F. Police arrived and recognised the vehicle. They took the Canadian into custody.
