Sec. 2. Duties.—The duties of each of these officers are in-

dicated in the installation ceremony.

SEC. 3. Terms and Elections.—The regular terms shall commence with the first meetings in February, May, August, and November. The officers shall be elected by majority vote at the last regular meeting in each term, and installed at the first meeting in the next term.

SEC. 4. Absence.—If any officer shall be absent from the Temple for three successive meetings without rendering, at the expiration of that time a valid excuse, the office may be declar-

ed vacant by the Superintendent.

SEC. 1. Offenses.—It shall be the duty of any member, know ing that another has violated the obligation, to immediately report the same to the Superintendent who, with the Executive Committee, shall take such action thereon as, in judgement, the best interests of the Temple and individual demand.

SEC. 2. Penalties.—Any member violating the obligation shall be subject to reprimand, suspension, or expulsion. No member shall be expelled but by vote of the Executive Committee.

## ARTICLE 8.

This Constitution may be altered or amended by the R. W. Grand Lodge at any regular session, a two-thirds vote concurring.

## BY-LAWS.

## MEETINGS.

2. Special meetings may be called by the Superintendent, but no business transacted other than that mentioned in the call.
