

in such manner out of the Institute, shall incur a fine of fifty cents, and shall not be allowed the privileges of the Library until the same be paid.

RULE X

If any Member lose or injure a Book belonging to the Library, he shall pay the value of, or replace the same; and if the Book belong to a set, he shall pay the value of, or replace the set.

RULE XI.

Any Member lending a Book to any other person shall be fined fifty cents.

RULE XII

The Superintendent shall be bound to see that the Rules of the Library be observed, endeavor to obtain all Books kept beyond the proper time, collect all fines, keep the Books in their proper place in the Library; and shall report, from time to time, to the Library Committee the names of any works kept beyond the proper time, or which may be lost, together with names of the Members who may keep or shall have lost them.

RULE XIII

The Library Committee shall examine the Books and report on the condition of the Library to the General Committee one week previous to each Annual Meeting; and for that purpose shall call in the Books one fortnight before that period, and any Member failing to return any Book after due notice, shall incur a penalty of ten cents a-day for each day the Book is detained.
