TOWNSHIP OF RALEIGH.

This township is bounded north by the River Thames; west by Tilbury East; north-east by Harwich; and south by Lake Erie. The general character of the soil is an exceedingly rich black loam, that portion of it on the front near Lake Erie, consisting of a gravel ridge and quicksand bottom, well adapted, however, for the growth of all kinds of fruit. There is a good deal of prairie land near the Thames, affording excellent grazing. A gravel road runs the length of its eastern boundary.

Two branches of the Thames run through this township. One enters the main stream about three miles below Chatham; the other joins it in Tilbury East, about a mile and a-half below the town line.
