long after she herself has entered upon her rest. Who can tell the precious harvest that may spring from seed thus sown! Departing saints in this way speak the message of Redeeming Love to thousands, even after their eyes close upon the light of this world.

## BIBLE COLPORTAGE IN PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.

We had the pleasure of co-operating for over two years with the Prince Edward Island Bible Society, which paid a portion of the expense of one of our Colporteurs to carry the Bibles of the Bitish and Foreign Bible Society in the Island. This arrangement was closed early this year; but a new arrangement has recently been made which will enable both our Colporteurs to work for the Bible Society throughout the island.

## TRAVELLING AGENTS.

Mr. A. B. Fletcher visited, in our interest, allotted sections in Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. Mr. John I. Sutcliffe travelled through New Brunswick. His work for the Society was closed at his own request, in consequence of his desire to pursue the studies necessary for entering into the ministry of the Gospel in connection with the Baptist Church. We wish him God speed in his chosen work.

Mr. Roland Mellish, having made a most successful season's Colportage, considering the hardness of the times, made collections for us in Newfoundland, and the friends there contributed heartily. He reports that our Society is becoming better known and is esteemed by all for its work sake. Messrs. Second and Walker, our faithful Colporteurs in Prince Edward Island, collected for us in the country districts and met with a favorable response. Mr. Job Wade, in King's Co., N. B., and Mr. Malcolm Macleod, in Cape Breton, rendered valuable service in the same direction. Ladies in Pictou lent their kind assistance.
