BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION.

The increasing use of concrete for a variety of purposes where stone, brick, or steel constructions were previously in favor, has resulted in its application to bridge construction, and a patent has been applied for by Messrs, E. von der Osten & Company, of 507 Manning Chambers, Toronto, in which a combination of steel wire rope and concrete is used. By this method, the advantage of the suspension principle is retained, and whilst the first cost is very much reduced, compared with that of re-enforced concrete, the facility with which it adapts itself to changes in temperature is its most valuable feature.

The von der Osten system of bridge construction is claimed to be the most scientific method of combining a concrete and metallic structure and can be applied to the construction of both ceilings and floors for fire-proof buildings. The patentees will be glad to give further information on application and are prepared to issue licenses to use their system to anyone engaged in concrete construction work.

Mr. von der Osten was engaged for many years in Germany, Russia and East Africa as a civil engineer in similar work, and his experience in such matters is very wide.
