THIS MEANS THAT WE MUST HAVE A PROTECTIVE TARIFF AT THE GREAT LAKES TO FENCE OUT THE "CHEAP LABOR" PRODUCTS OF EASTERN CANADA BEFORE WE CAN HAVE ANY FACTORIES IN THE PRAIRIE PROVINCES. THE GRAIN GROWERS, HOWEVER, ARE OPPOSED TO THIS POLICY OF SPLITTING UP CANADA. THEY WOULD REMOVE THE TARIFF ENTIRELY AND MAKE THE COST OF PRODUCTION SO CHEAP FOR LEGITIMATE INDUSTRIES THAT FOREIGN COMPETITION WOULD BE IMPOS SIBLE. THAT IS THE POLICY EVERY GOOD BUSINESS MAN FOLLOWS IN HIS OWN BUSI-NESS. CIVILIZATION HAS NOW ADVANCED TO THE STAGE WHERE COMMON SENSE SHOULD BE APPLIED IN NATIONAL BUSI NESS AFFAIRS.
