## NEWFOUNDLAND.

THOS. COCHRANE, Governor.

By His Excellency SIR THOMAS JOHN COCHRANE, Knight, Governor Proclamation for Proand Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Newfoundland roguing the Parliament to Friday, the 10th January, 1834.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued to Friday the 1st day of November next;

I have therefore thought fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Friday the 10th day of January next, then to meet for the Despatch of Business: of which all persons concerned are desired to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

> Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Government House at St. John's, the 5th day of October, in the Year of our Lord 1833, in the Fourth Year of His Majesty's Reign.

By a further Proclamation of His Excellency SIR THOMAS JOHN COCHRANE, Governor The Parliament further of Newfoundland, dated the 16th day of December, 1833, the meeting of the General Assembly Prorogned to Wednesday 29th January, 1834. stands further Prorogued to Wednesday the 29th day of January, then next ensuing.
